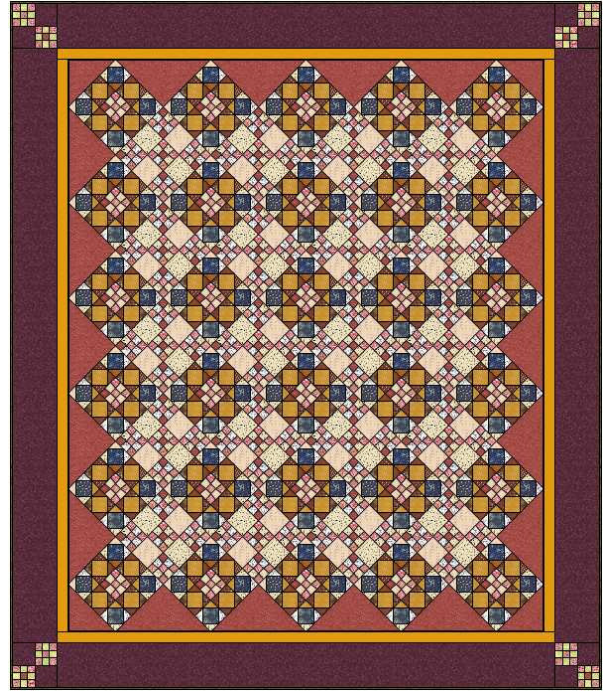
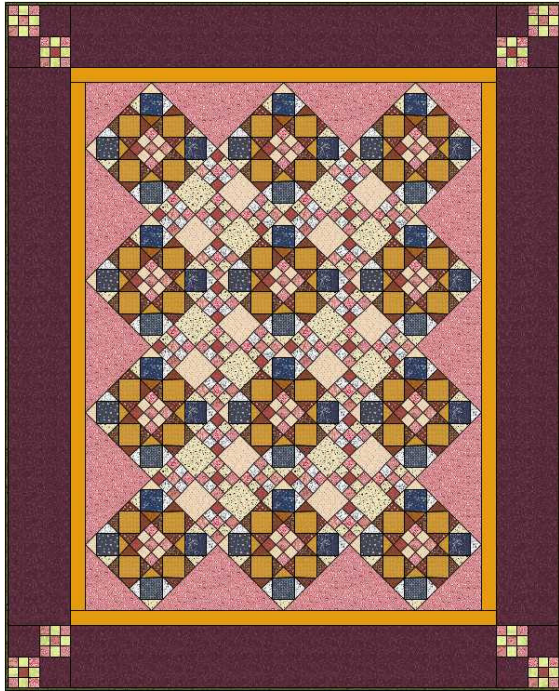


Double Delight

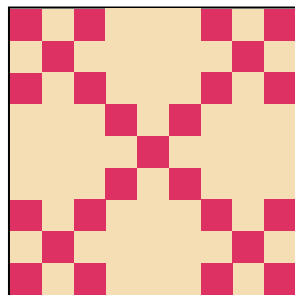

Welcome to the spring quilting class. The quilt we will be making was originally a mystery quilt designed by Bonnie K. Hunter. Bonnie's designs are very scrap-friendly and there are many other great quilt patterns available on her website Quiltville.com

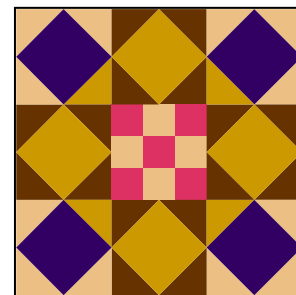
There will be two size options for this class, a lap/throw size (54 X 66) or double bed size (79 X 92)



The design uses only two blocks and they are set on point. The blocks are 9" in the finished quilts.


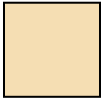






Double 9-patch



Kansas Star variation

This quilt can be a “controlled” scrappy design or all single fabrics. These are the colors used in the sample and the directions, but feel free to use any color scheme that appeals to you. Contrast (the light-ness or dark-ness) between the fabrics is as important to the design as the color. These are generous amounts, but one of the great things about scrap quilts is that if you run short of one fabric, you can add in something else and it will look like you planned it that way!

Diagram color	Fabric	Cut type	Lap	Full
	Pinks	scraps, strips, FQs (fat quarters), yardage or a combination of all	1 1/2 yard	3 yards
	Light/ background	Light neutrals, shirtings	1 yard	1 3/4 yards
	Indigo type blues	can use several	1/2 yard	3/4 yard
	Dark Chocolate Brown	1 piece of yardage, but you can split it into several	1/2 yard	1 1/2 yards
	Gold/Cheddar	1 piece of yardage, but you can split it up into other fabrics of the same color family if you want as with the brown above	1 yard	1 yard
	Border	Could be a print or read as solid. You can even wait until your top is together.	1 1/2 yard	2 yards
