

Scrap Basket Mystery

Step 2

Short Instructions:

Make 70 half-square triangles with an un-finished size of 3 1/2" (3" finished) so that the finished unit is dark on one half and light on the other. Use whatever technique(s) you like. If you have an Easy Angle ruler, try using short strips rather than full width of fabric. You can then pair-up your darks and lights at random and get more diversity in you HSTs. Get more random pairings of lights and darks, if you are using the square-at-a-time method described below, by putting your squares in two bags (one for lights one for darks). Choose a square from each bag to sew together.

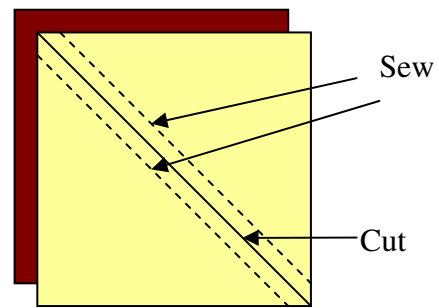
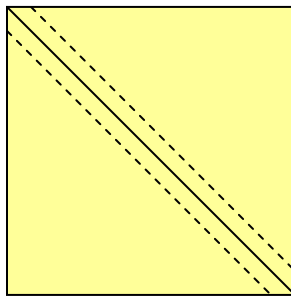
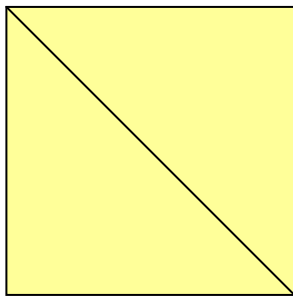

Sewing Instructions:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of each light square.



2. Draw a line 1/4" on each side of the drawn diagonal line (Or use the Quick-cut ruler)
3. Layer the light square with a dark square, right sides together. Sew on the dotted lines.
4. Cut on the solid line.
5. Press your half-square triangles (HST) open with the seam allowance toward the accent fabric.
6. Square-up to 3 1/2" and place in a bag labeled Step #2.
